October 5, 2017
“Unapproved Meeting Minutes”

The Village of Ubly Regular Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. October 5, 2017 at the Bingham/Village Government Center.

Attendance: In attendance were - President David Jaroch; Trustees; Larry Western, Victoria Rutkowski, Jason Nicol, Larry Gornowicz, Lola Brown and Susan Schrader; Clerk, Barb Butch, Treasurer Kelly Pearce, Police Chief Dave Rothe, Water Administrator Lori White and DPW Supervisor Carl Weber. There were 12 citizens in attendance.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Public Comment: Village resident Chris Peruski thanked the Village Clerk for the in depth minutes that are published in the newspaper.

President Jaroch turned the floor over to Prosecuting Attorney Tim Rutkowski and Police Chief Dave Rothe in regards to Medical Marijuana Public Act 281. Tim updated Council and the public on what Public Act 281 is and how it impacts communities. Dave Rothe informed Council that the current ordinance is no longer viable and does not conform to Public Act 281. Chief Rothe recommends that the Village rescind our current ordinance and wait and see what happens on the November 2018 ballot.

Water Report: Council looked over the water report by Lori White. Meters will be read and the next billing will be sent out around October 15th.

Clerks Report: September 7, 2017 minutes were presented to Council. Lola Brown made a motion to approve minutes, seconded by Larry Gornowicz. All in favor, motion carried.

July bills were presented to Council. Victoria Rutkowski made a motion to accept the September bills as presented, seconded by Larry Western. Victoria questioned a bill for sand purchased for a new sidewalk put in wondering where the sidewalk was. Susan Schrader then questioned who authorized the project.

After a lengthy discussion with no resolution, all other items on the agenda were tabled and President Jaroch adjourned the meeting at 7:50 p.m.
