7 residents were in attendance.

Agenda: Public comment on the agenda - none. A motion was made by Jeff Rubin to approve the agenda as presented with additions, seconded by Brandon Zdrojewski. All in favor, motion passed.

Communications: Received a check from the United Methodist Church for 2 swings and a tree to be placed by the new walking path in the park next year in memory of Lola Brown and Tom Trusock.

Clerks Report: Regular Council meeting minutes were presented. A motion to approve the September 5th, Regular meeting minutes was made by Brandon Zdrojewski, seconded by Andrew Batzer. All in favor, motion passed.

Bills were presented to Council. A motion to pay the bills was made by Brandon Zdrojewski, seconded by Sara Schmidt. All in favor, motion passed.

Treasurer’s Report: Larry Gornowicz presented the Treasurer’s report. Village Taxes have been collected for 2019. The report was accepted pending audit.

Police Report/ Jeff Rubin: Knights of Columbus tootsie roll drive – Oct. 12th. Officer Matt Clark saved a person’s life this past weekend using the AED device.

Public Works/ Brandon Zdrojewski: Work that was done in the last month: Fixing sidewalks, painting curbs, put up no parking signs, chlorine pumps changed and calibrated, replacing water meters no longer working.

Unfinished Business:

Band Boosters Banners – The club will put up student signs first on Main and then Union Street. They will be on the inside of the light poles. A motion was made to allow the banners on Main Street and then Union by Jeff Rubin and seconded by Brandon Zdrojewski. All in favor, motion passed.

New Business:

- Bids for shed repair on village farm property were opened and discussed. The insurance check was received for \$6347.00 for damages done. The Bids were opened. Electric Bids: 1st Bid - \$950.00, 2nd bid - \$945.00; Roof replaced and new garage doors: 1st Bid - \$9800, 2nd Bid - \$6945.76.

A motion was made to accept the bid of \$6945.76 from Joe Particka by Sara Schmidt seconded by Brandon Zdrojewski. All in favor, motion passed.

A motion was made to accept the bid of \$950.00 from Wright Electric by Brandon Zdrojewski, seconded by Jeff Rubin. All in favor, motion passed.

- Ugly Band Boosters – Jennifer Nicol, band director asked the Council as a civic group to recognize the Band Boosters as a nonprofit organization for them to be able to seek their own 501c3 status for gaming licenses. A resolution was made by Jeff Rubin and seconded by Sara Schmidt that the Ugly Band Boosters be considered as a nonprofit organization. All in favor, motion passed.

Trick or Treat hours for Ugly will be Thursday, Oct. 31st from 5:30 – 7. A motion was made by Brandon Zdrojewski seconded by Sara Schmidt to approve the Trick or Treat hours. All in favor, motion passed.

- Traffic Control Order 88p – Union street from the corner of M19 to the river to have no parking on the South side of the street 2:00 – 3:30 p.m. during school days. Brandon/Andrew to approve traffic control order 88p. All in favor, motion passed.

School is asking for no parking on M19 during certain times of the day, Jason will be sending a letter to MDOT with the request.

There being no further business, a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:09 p.m. was made by Sara Schmidt, seconded by Brandon Zdrojewski. All in favor, meeting adjourned.
