

Village of Ubyly
Regular Council Meeting
June 4, 2020 @ 7:30 PM
“Approved Meeting Minutes”

The Village of Ubyly Regular Meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. on June 4, 2020 at the Bingham/Village Government Center and online thru Lifesize. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Attendance: In attendance were President Jason Nicol, Trustees Brandon Zdrojewski, Gabe Turner, Steve Irvine, Sara Schmidt, Andrew Batzer, DPW Supervisor Dave Franzel, Treasurer Larry Gornowicz and Clerk Barb Butch. Trustee Jeff Rubin and Police Chief Dave Rothe attended online. There was 1 resident was in attendance at the hall and 1 online.

Agenda: Public comment on the agenda - none. A motion was made by Gabe Turner to approve the agenda as presented, seconded by Andrew Batzer. A roll call vote was done: Zdrojewski-aye, Batzer-aye, Schmidt-aye, Irvine-aye, Turner-aye, Rubin-aye, Nicol-aye. All in favor, motion passed.

Communications: The railroad tracks on M19, north of the Village will be closed the June 8 thru July, depending on weather.

A letter was read for resident Chuck Wright on his parent's house having issues with water being pumped to the curb from a nearby residence. It then flows to the end of their driveway and in the winter causes ice buildup. Asking if anything can be done.

Clerks Report: Regular Council meeting minutes were presented. A motion to approve the May 6, 2020 Regular meeting minutes was made by Sara Schmidt, seconded by Gabe Turner. All in favor, motion passed.

Bills were presented to Council. A motion to pay the bills was made by Brandon Zdrojewski seconded by Gabe Turner. A roll call vote was done: Zdrojewski-aye, Batzer-aye, Schmidt-aye, Irvine-aye, Turner-aye, Rubin-aye, Nicol-aye. All in favor, motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: Larry Gornowicz presented his report. The report was accepted pending audit.

Police Report/ Jeff Rubin: Police Chief Dave Rothe brought to Council's attention that the Park's can now be opened back up.

Public Works/ Brandon Zdrojewski: Various seasonal work was done in the last month. Warranty work on water tower is being done. Well #7 is having an electrical issue.

Unfinished Business: A motion was made by Gabe Turner, seconded by Brandon Zdrojewski to reopen the Parks & Rec areas on June 5, 2020. A roll call vote was done: Zdrojewski-aye, Batzer-aye, Schmidt-aye, Irvine-aye, Turner-aye, Rubin-aye, Nicol-aye. All in favor, motion passed.

New Business: A water catch basin was discussed to fix the issue on Main St. A motion to allow Dave Franzel to install a sub pump drain on Main St. was made by Steve Irvine, seconded by Brandon Zdrojewski. A roll call vote was done: Zdrojewski-aye, Batzer-aye, Schmidt-aye, Irvine-aye, Turner-aye, Rubin-aye, Nicol-aye. All in favor, motion passed.

Bingham Twp. Fire Dept. asked if they could access Well #5 for filling their trucks. The Village does not use this well. A motion was made by Brandon Zdrojewski, seconded by Andrew Batzer to allow the fire dept. to connect to Well #5 at their expense and upkeep. A roll call vote was done: Zdrojewski-aye, Batzer-aye, Schmidt-aye, Irvine-aye, Turner-aye, Rubin-aye, Nicol-aye. All in favor, motion passed.

Mike Delpiere attended online and explained to Council he is the owner of the new Ubyly Pharmacy located near the park. He is hoping it will be opening mid-July or early August. One of the stipulations by the County is he needs handicap parking.

A motion was made by Gabe Turner, seconded by Sara Schmidt to approve handicap parking in front of the Pharmacy. A roll call vote was done: Zdrojewski-aye, Batzer-aye, Schmidt-aye, Irvine-aye, Turner-aye, Rubin-aye, Nicol-aye. All in favor, motion passed. Jason or Dave will contact Mike on the cost of the sign, painting and labor.

The renewal of the Village employee's Blue Cross Blue Shield was presented, there will be a \$91 per month increase.

A motion was made by Steve Irvine, seconded by Gabe Turner to renew the existing BCBS insurance policy for the 2020/2021 year. A roll call vote was done: Zdrojewski-aye, Batzer-aye, Schmidt-aye, Irvine-aye, Turner-aye, Rubin-aye, Nicol-aye. All in favor, motion passed.

A motion was made to purchase a new computer for the Water Billing was made by Gabe Turner, seconded

by Sara Schmidt. A roll call vote was done: Zdrowjewski-aye, Batzer-aye, Schmidt-aye, Irvine-aye, Turner-aye, Rubin-aye, Nicol-aye. All in favor, motion passed.

Public Comment:

Jason reminded all that running in the November election must have their paperwork turned into Joe Rutkowski by the end of June.

Brandon Zdrojewski thanked Council for approving the moving of the Village sign over a few feet by his business and the DPW for getting the job done.

There being no further business, a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:21p.m. was made by Sara Schmidt, seconded by Gabe Turner. All in favor, meeting adjourned.
