

**Village of Ubly**  
**Regular Council Meeting**  
**July 2, 2020 @ 7:30 PM**  
**“Approved Meeting Minutes”**

The Village of Ubly Regular Meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. on July 2, 2020 at the Bingham/Village Government Center. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

**Attendance:** In attendance were President Jason Nicol, Trustees Brandon Zdrojewski, Gabe Turner, Jeff Rubin, Sara Schmidt, Andrew Batzer, DPW Supervisor Dave Franzel, Police Chief Dave Rothe, Treasurer Larry Gornowicz and Clerk Barb Butch. Trustee Steve Irvine had an excused absence. There were 4 residents in attendance at the hall.

**Agenda:** Public comment on the agenda – none. A motion was made by Gabe Turner to approve the agenda as presented, seconded by Jeff Rubin. All in favor, motion passed.

**Communications:** Brad Klebba representing MT Pocket Pullers, asked Council to entertain the notion to hold a tractor pull in August. They are insured and would take care of everything. It would be free to the public. Council will watch COVID numbers and review this at the August 6<sup>th</sup> Council meeting. Brad also asked Council to contact an owner of a apartment building concerning trash that is not being disposed of properly by renters and then blows onto his father’s property. Chief Rothe said he will contact the owner about the situation.

**Clerks Report:** Regular Council meeting minutes were presented. A motion to approve the June 4, 2020 Regular meeting minutes was made by Gabe Turner, seconded by Brandon Zdrojewski. All in favor, motion passed.

Bills were presented to Council. A motion to pay the bills was made by Brandon Zdrojewski seconded by Gabe Turner. All in favor, motion passed.

**Treasurer’s Report:** Larry Gornowicz presented his report. The report was accepted pending audit.

**Police Report/ Jeff Rubin:** Police Chief Dave Rothe reported that Ubly PD had firearms training.

**Public Works/ Brandon Zdrojewski:** Various seasonal work was done in the last month. Lead/Copper testing done on water. Work was started on the walking path in the park.

**New Business:** A motion was made by Gabe Turner, seconded by Andrew Batzer to approve the low bid by Booms construction on the Park Walking Path and Pavilion project. All in favor, motion passed.

Preconstruction meeting will be Thurs. July 9<sup>th</sup> at the park.

A motion was made by Gabe Turner, seconded by Sara Schmidt to accept the low bid by Halfway Fence Co. to replace the fence between resident properties, the Walking Path and the DPW. All in favor, motion carried.

A motion was made by Gabe Turner, seconded by Jeff Rubin to approve the low bid by Bischer Ready-mix as the concrete supplier for portions of the walking path project. All in favor, motion carried.

2019/20 Village Audit is almost complete, it was all done remotely.

**Public Comment:** None.

There being no further business, a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:56 p.m. was made by Gabe Turner, seconded by Sara Schmidt. All in favor, meeting adjourned.
