

Village of Ubly
Regular Council Meeting
September 3, 2020 @ 7:40 PM
“Approved Meeting Minutes”

The Village of Ubly Regular Meeting was called to order at 7:40 p.m. September 3, 2020 outdoors at Veterans Park under the Pavilion. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Attendance: In attendance were President Jason Nicol, Trustees Jeff Rubin, Gabe Turner, Steve Irvine, Sara Schmidt, Andrew Batzer, DPW Supervisor Dave Franzel, Police Chief Dave Rothe, Treasurer Larry Gornowicz and Clerk Barb Butch. Brandon Zdrojewski was excused. 3 residents were in attendance.

Agenda: Public comment on the agenda - none. A motion was made by Gabe Turner to approve the agenda as presented, seconded by Jeff Rubin. All in favor, motion passed.

Clerks Report: Regular Council meeting minutes were presented. A motion to approve the August 6, 2020 Regular meeting minutes was made by Steve Irvine, seconded by Gabe Turner. All in favor, motion passed. Bills were presented to Council. A motion to pay the bills was made by Gabe Turner, seconded by Jeff Rubin. All in favor, motion passed.

Treasurer’s Report: Larry Gornowicz presented the Treasurer’s report. The report was accepted pending audit.

Police Report/ Jeff Rubin: None.

Public Works/ Brandon Zdrojewski: Work that was done in the last month: Moved items to make way for the new Walking Path in the park, usual mowing, maintenance on salt shed. Point to point radio antenna connecting the Village Hall and DPW/ Water office were damaged by lightning and were replaced.

Parks: Walking Path in the park to start after Labor Day.

New Business: Jason Nicol announced that the Village will be posting the Water Billing position. Lori White moved from the area. A motion was made by Gabe Turner seconded by Andrew Batzer to post the Water Billing position in the paper, on Facebook, our website and on the sign in the Park. All in favor, motion passed. A Committee of Jeff Rubin, Andrew Batzer, Jason Nicol and Dave Franzel will review applications and make a suggestion to Council at the October 1st meeting.

Jason Nicol announced that the Village will be posting a fulltime position for a DPW Laborer. It will also be posted in the paper, on Facebook, our website and on the sign in the Park. A committee will be formed at the October Council meeting to view applications, schedule interviews and the top 3 will be at the Nov. 5th Council meeting. A motion was made by Gabe Turner, seconded by Sara Schmidt to post the DPW Laborer full time position. All in favor, motion passed.

Jason went over the Mers Adoption Agreement. A motion was made by Steve Irvine, seconded by Gabe Turner to accept the Mers Adoption Agreement. All in favor, motion passed.

Jason had the Council review a sheet of masonry colors for the columns and bathrooms of the Pavilion. A motion was made by Sara Schmidt, seconded by Gabe Turner to approve the Gray/Blue sample, second row, 4th from the left. All in favor, motion passed.

Public Comment: Larry Gornowicz wanted to know what the water billing responsibilities are. Doreen Zulauf asked Council to consider updating the tennis courts lines and maybe adding pickleball lines to the courts.

There being no further business, a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:12 p.m. was made by Sara Schmidt, seconded by Jeff Rubin. All in favor, meeting adjourned.
