

**Village of Ubly
Council Meeting
July 1, 2021 @ 7:30 p.m.
"Approved Meeting Minutes"**

The Village of Ubly Regular Council Meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m., July 1, 2021 at the Bingham/Village Government Center.

Attendance: In attendance were President Jason Nicol, Trustees Brandon Zdrojewski, Sara Schmidt, Jeff Rubin, Gabe Turner, Clerk Barb Butch, Treasurer Larry Gornowicz, DPW Supervisor Dave Franzel, Police Chief Dave Rothe and Water Supervisor Theresa Murdock. Steve Irvine and Jeff Maurer were absent. There was 3 in the audience.

Agenda: A motion was made by Gabe Turner seconded by Brandon Zdrojewski to accept the agenda as presented. All in favor. Motion passed.

Communications: President Nicol talked to a representative of Emterra concerning a renewal of the garbage contract. They will be getting back with him and he will have more information for the August meeting.

Clerk's Report: A motion was made by Sara Schmidt seconded by Gabe Turner to approve the June 3, 2021 Regular Council Meeting Minutes. All in favor. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Brandon Zdrojewski seconded by Sara Schmidt to pay the June 2021 bills. All in favor. Motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: Larry presented the Treasurer's Report. Council accepted the report pending audit. Larry is training Ashley Holdwick as deputy clerk.

Police Report: Jeff Rubin/Dave Rothe informed Council they only have 2 officers working for the Homecoming, Rothe will contact the Homecoming committee on the matter. School crossing guards did a great job this year. Thanked the DPW for helping fix the garage door.

Parks and Rec: Cleaning up the Nature Trail on the South end of the Village, putting down additional mulch, cleaning up dead ash trees. Would like to put in some bollards to stop ATV's/Golf Carts from going into it and tearing it up. Cost for 3 is \$333.

Motion by Jeff Rubin seconded by Sara Schmidt to allow the purchase of 3 bollards to be installed on the Nature Trail. All in favor. Motion passed.

Public Works: General seasonal work is being done, painting curbs. DTE is removing old light poles. Gas & electric to building at 4400 Pike will be removed by July 14th.

WaterReport: 2nd quarter water bills were sent out. Due date is Aug. 4 with shut off's slated for Aug. 24.

Unfinished Business: The second reading of the Chicken Ordinance was presented. The ordinance will be posted on the Village Website and also at the hall and Library. It was decided that a public hearing will be conducted at 7:15 p.m. August 5th, before the regular Council Meeting.

New Business:

- Traffic control order 7T was submitted, closing ½ block of Main Street for the Musicfest on July 3rd.

- Planning Commission President Jim Zulauf brought to the Council's attention that Harv McIntyre's seat on the commission had expired in March 2021. Harv would like to cover another 3 years, retroactive to March.

A motion was made by Brandon Zdrojewski seconded by Gabe Turner to reappoint Harv McIntyre to the Planning Commission from March 2021 to March 2024. All in favor. Motion passed.

Public Comment:

Barb Butch reminded everyone that the old Village banners are now for sale at the library, cost is \$25.

There being no further business a motion was made by Sara Schmidt seconded by Gabe Turner to adjourn the meeting at 8:05 p.m.
