Agenda: A motion was made by Sara Schmidtseconded by Jeff Rubinto accept the agenda as presented. All in favor, motion carried. **Public Comment on the Agenda:** None.

Communications: None.

<u>Clerk's Report:</u> A motion was made by Jeff Rubinseconded by Brandon Zdrojewskito approve the August 4, 2022, Regular Council Meeting Minutes with correction. All in favor, motion carried.

A motion was made by Sara Schmidt seconded by Brandon Zdrojewski to pay the September 2022 bills. All in favor, motion carried. **Treasurer's Report**: Larry presented the Treasurer's Report. Council accepted the report pending audit.

- c. Brandon Zdrojewski informed Council that DTE was in the area checking on poles and will be replacing them as needed.

New Business:

a. Trick or Treat hours for the Village of Ubly were discussed. A motion was made by Sara Schmidt seconded by Jeff Rubin to set Trick or Treat hours for Monday, October 31 from 5:30 – 7 p.m. All in favor, motion carried.

Public Comment:

Zoning Admin Jason Nicol informed Council that the property split requested by Chris David was denied. There were various factors that prevented this being approved.

Planning Commission Jim Zulauf informed Council that the Rec & Master Plan are due to be reviewed and updated. This must be done every 5 years. He also said that it was recommended that the Zoning Ordinance be updated. Jason Nicol will contact Steven Rutkowski from Spicer Group on a course of action.
