Water Report:3rd Quarter water bills were sent out. There were 26 top registers that had to be replaced.

Unfinished Business:

- b. Village lawyer is working on finalizing all paperwork on 4370 Pike Street.

New Business:

- a. DPW employee 457 Plan. They are asking for a 5% match. More information will be brought to the November meeting. Vince is also looking into water operator training and classes.
- b. Discussion on ordering additional water meters. A motion was made by Brandon Zdrojewski seconded by Gabe Turner to order 60 top meters for the water dept. All in favor, motion carried.

Resident Calvin Messing asked if anything can be done for his driveway approach. It is very steep and vehicles hit bottom at times. President Nicol said he and Dave Franzel would look at it and give him a cost estimate on fixing it.
