

**Village of Ubly
Council Meeting
December 4, 2025 @ 7:30 p.m.
"Unapproved Meeting Minutes"**

The Village of Ubly Regular Council Meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m., December 4, 2025, at the Bingham/Village Government Center.

In attendance were President Pro Tem Jeff Rubin, Trustees: Sara Schmidt, Mitch Holdwick, Brandon Zdrojewski and Aaron LaPonsie, Clerk Barbara Butch, Treasurer Larry Gornowicz and DPW Supervisor Dave Franzel. President Jason Nicol, Trustee Tracey Foster and Police Chief Anthony Wood were absent. 10 residents also attended.

Agenda: A motion was made by Brandon Zdrojewski seconded by Mitch Holdwick to accept the agenda. All in favor, motion carried.

Public Comment on the Agenda: None.

Communications: DPW Supervisor Dave Franzel passed out a statement concerning the wording of the November 6, 2025 Council Meeting minutes and asked that the statement be put in his personal file. Pres. Pro Tem Rubin acknowledged receiving the statement and tabled it until the January meeting to let all Council members a chance to read it.

Clerk's Report: Due to a wording conflict on the November 6 meeting minutes, approval was tabled until the January 8th Council meeting.

A motion was made by Brandon Zdrojewski seconded by Sara Schmidt to pay the December bills. All in favor, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: The treasurer's report was presented and accepted pending audit.

Police Report: The new firearms arrived. Before any use they need to be qualified.

Public Works: Dave thanked Jim Zulauf for helping take the pickleball nets down and cover the cranks for winter, snow plowing, put up the Christmas lights and Nativity Scene. Updated Miss Dig system and doing maintenance on equipment.

Water Billing: Third quarter billing is almost complete and around the first of January the 4th Quarter Water Bills will be going out in the mail.

Ambulance Board Report: Terry Jimpkowski reported the Authority is on hold until signed by the Governor, 5 new iPads were purchased.

- a. Skate Ramps. Jacob Weiss spoke about keeping the skate ramps in Ubly. No decision has been made concerning the ramps at this time.

New Business: None.
